Hello Everyone,

The trials/practices enjoyed a very good level of student participation and interest and the behaviour, leadership and willingness to help out at all times by our senior students was first class.

A schedule of events is attached to this week's newsletter. Programmes will be available to parents on Friday or from the front office from today (Wednesday, 11th March).

All students are encouraged to wear casual clothing in their house colours ~ remembering that this clothing should be suitable for competition and attendance at a school function. Students should also remember to protect themselves well from the sun with a broad brimmed hat and sunscreen applied often throughout the day. 



