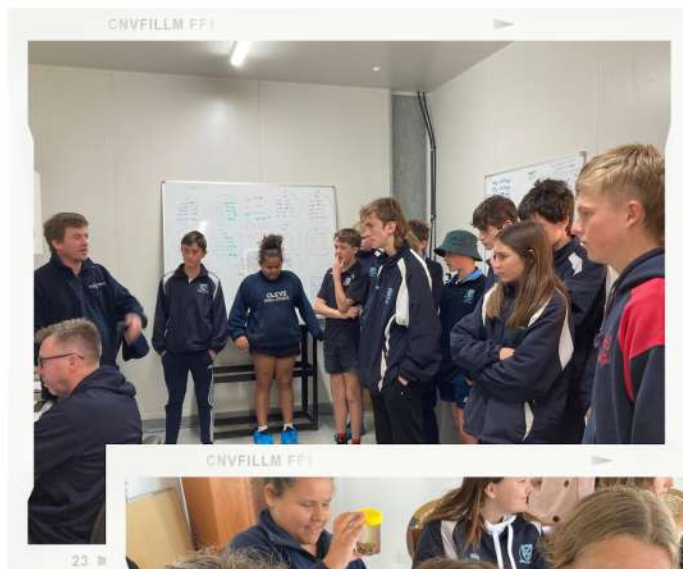

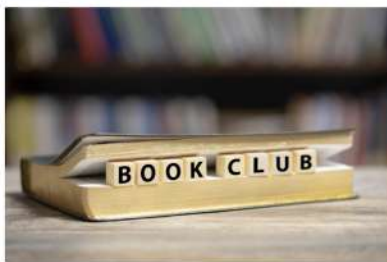

For children attending Cleve Preschool in 2023

We are currently seeking numbers for Preschool for 2023.

Please contact Missy.hartwig742@schools.sa.edu.au via email before the 16th September 2022 if you are looking at enrolling your child at Cleve Preschool for an expression of interest form or to request hard copy – please include your address.

Eligibility for Preschool:

Children are entitled to access 4 terms (1year) of Government Preschool in the year before they start school.

We are introducing a mid-year intake into Preschool.

This means that from 2023 children who turn 4 years old:

- Before 1 May, are eligible to start Preschool at the beginning of the year.
- On 1 May to 31 October can commence preschool through the mid - year intake at the start of term 3 of that year.

Regardless of whether your child starts at the beginning of the year, or through a mid-year intake they will undertake 4 terms of Preschool.

Children who turn 4 years after 31 October will be eligible to commence Preschool at the start of the following year.

Immunisation requirements before starting Preschool:

Children cannot be enrolled in or attend Preschool unless all immunisation requirements are met. (No jab, No Play)
